- ☐ Ask a nature teacher for help if I cannot resolve a disagreement/conflict

The Nature Place Nature Teachers will review these guidelines at the start of every program. Nature Teachers will address behavior mostly through positive reinforcement, firm statements, and redirection of activity.
